Microphones	2 headset and 2 lapel microphones + one hand held radio microphone + fixed microphone on stand are available
Hearing loop	Yes
Beginning of service welcome	By the duty steward which they will follow with a prayer for peace
Notices	Any notices will be announced
Offering arrangements/timing	As decided by the preacher but preferably not during a hymn
Music	Organ and piano. Rota of organists. We have cd recordings of all of the tunes from Singing the Faith played on the piano
Printed word copies	Hymn material not in StF can be made available if at least 24 hours' notice is given to Sue Byard:
Facilities for playing CD's & DVD's	Yes. Both CD's & DVD's can be played through the available system
Average number of adults & children	35 adults aged 55+
Children's address	No children usually attend
Do children leave for Sunday School/Junior church	If any children are at church they are given the opportunity to go out to another room or have an activity book
All Age Worship	Occasionally
Bible reading rota	Yes. Two readers for each Sunday
Intercessions prayer book	Yes. Updated each week and brought to preacher usually at dedication of offerings
