On 8th December at 4.30 we have our Christingle Service, this year being led by Rev. Vic Downs and Karen Willing, this is a lovely service for the children when they are all given a Christingle to take home, although many don't get that far as the sweets are eaten very quickly.

Our Sisterhood group always hold a Christmas Buffet for members plus all the speakers who have given their time through to year to talk to the group.

It will be a busy day on Saturday, 14th December, when we give away on our church steps, mince pies wrapped in a nice serviette with a Christmas message, to all who pass by. Meanwhile there is a coffee morning for our Kenyan School Library Project in Kiziamango from 10am till noon. This will be followed by a soup lunch before we go carol singing for Christian Aid in our St. George's Centre.

The following day, 15^{th} we hold our Toy Service at 11 am, this year led by Monica Wilding, we bring toys for the needy in Gravesend, also a pair of pants or socks Christmas wrapped with a bar of chocolate, these are sent up to the Whitechapel Mission, who we regularly support.

Every year a group goes round to our housebound friends to sing carols, this is welcomed by all those who now are unable to join us at our Church services.


Our Family Carol Service is at 4.30pm on 22nd December.
