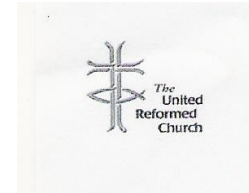

This year he is returning to Queenborough to present his art exhibition “New Vision”. The Exhibition will take place in a familiar setting for Robin, Holy Trinity Church Queenborough. It will be open to the public on Saturday 5th March from 10am – 5pm with talks given by Robin at 12noon and 3pm. The art work will also be on display on Sunday 6th March 10am – 11am.
