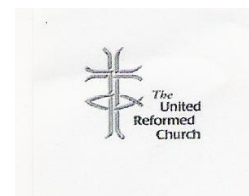
It meets on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month

KERRY WEST ORPHANAGE PROJECT
